

Golf Scramble Rules for 316 Golf Tournament:

1. Player Order:
 - Players can determine their order of play on each hole and each shot.
2. The Tee Shot:
 - Each player on the team tees off on each hole.
 - The team then, collectively, selects the best tee shot.
 - Men 70 and over play from the Yellow tees Except prize holes - all play from the marked Tees
 - Men Under 70 play from the White tees. Except prize holes – all play from the marked Tees
 - Ladies – from the Forward Tees - Except prize holes - all play from the marked Tees
3. Playing from the Best Shot:
 - Teams must use at least one drive from all players on one of the 14 drivable holes (not par 3's).
 - All team members then hit their next shot from the location of the selected tee shot.
 - The team repeats this process of selecting a new best shot after each stroke, until the ball is holed.
4. Distance and Placing the Ball:
 - Each team member can place their ball within one club length of the selected shot, but no closer to the hole.
 - This rule applies even if the selected shot is in a hazard, the rough, or on the green.
 - If the ball selected is in a bunker, all shots must be played from the bunker.
5. Recording Scores:
 - Only one score is recorded per team for each hole, based on the best ball at each stage of play.
6. Pace of Play:
 - Scrambling can be particularly time-consuming. Be mindful of the time and use good common sense in keeping the round moving.
 - Pick up after Bogey and move on to the next hole.
7. Determining the Winning Team:
 - The team with the lowest scores wins the tournament.
 - Tie breakers will be resolved by reviewing each team's scorecard starting from the highest handicap hole to lowest, until a winner is determined. If still tied after this process, a coin flip will determine the winner.
8. Mulligans
 - Must be purchased at Check in prior to Tournament Start and are limited to 1 per person.
 - May be used for any shots – Except on Prize hole(s)
